Composition of a Promotional Song for Liberia Census 2021

The Government of Liberia through the Liberia Institute of Statistics and Geo-Information Services (LISGIS) in Collaboration with the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) has begun the process leading to the conduct of the next Liberia Population and Housing Census in 2021.

A population census is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing, publishing and disseminating demographic, economic and social data for all persons in a delimited territory or country at a specified time. It is the largest data collection exercise in a country and covers the whole country and provides information on every person within its borders; from the newly born babies to the oldest person as well as for nationals and non-nationals.

As part of its publicity activities, LISGIS endeavors to have a song to promote all the stages of Liberia Census 2021.

In view of the above, LISGIS is requesting all interested local Artists to submit a demo not longer than 3 minutes for consideration.

A Committee will review the Demos based on the below criteria and come up with a recommendation to the management of LISGIS:

- Language
- Style
- Tempo
- Originality

The successful Artist(s) will be awarded the contract to record the song which will be the Sole Property of LISGIS.
